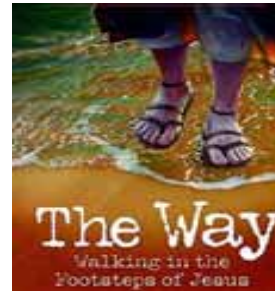
DONUTS
