Welcome to Larry and Julie Possehl who have transferred from First United Methodist Church in Fargo.

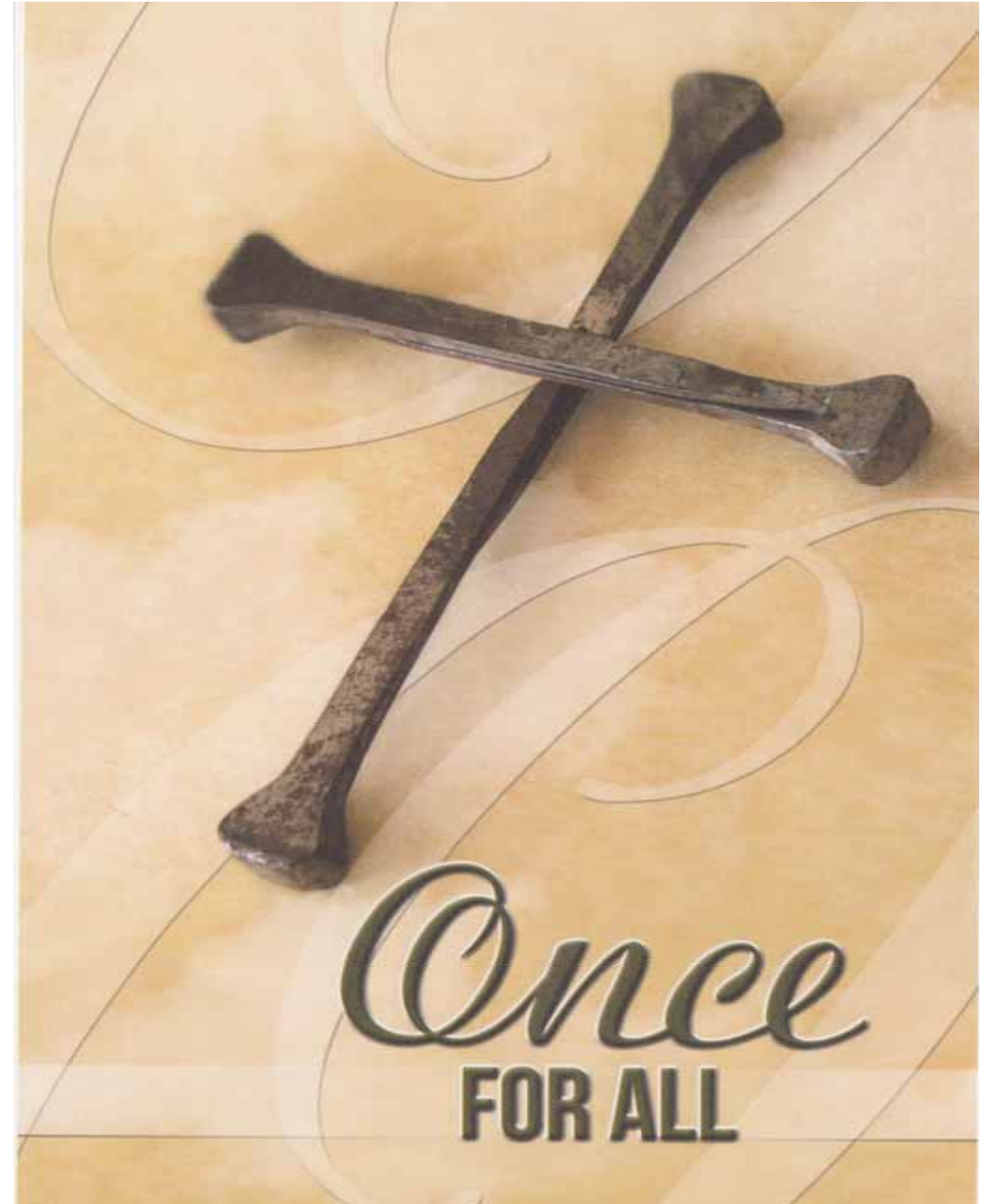
