Quart and pint jars as well as jar lids and rings are needed for the Nov. 7 Fall Festival. If you can donate, please bring them to the church kitchen back counter.

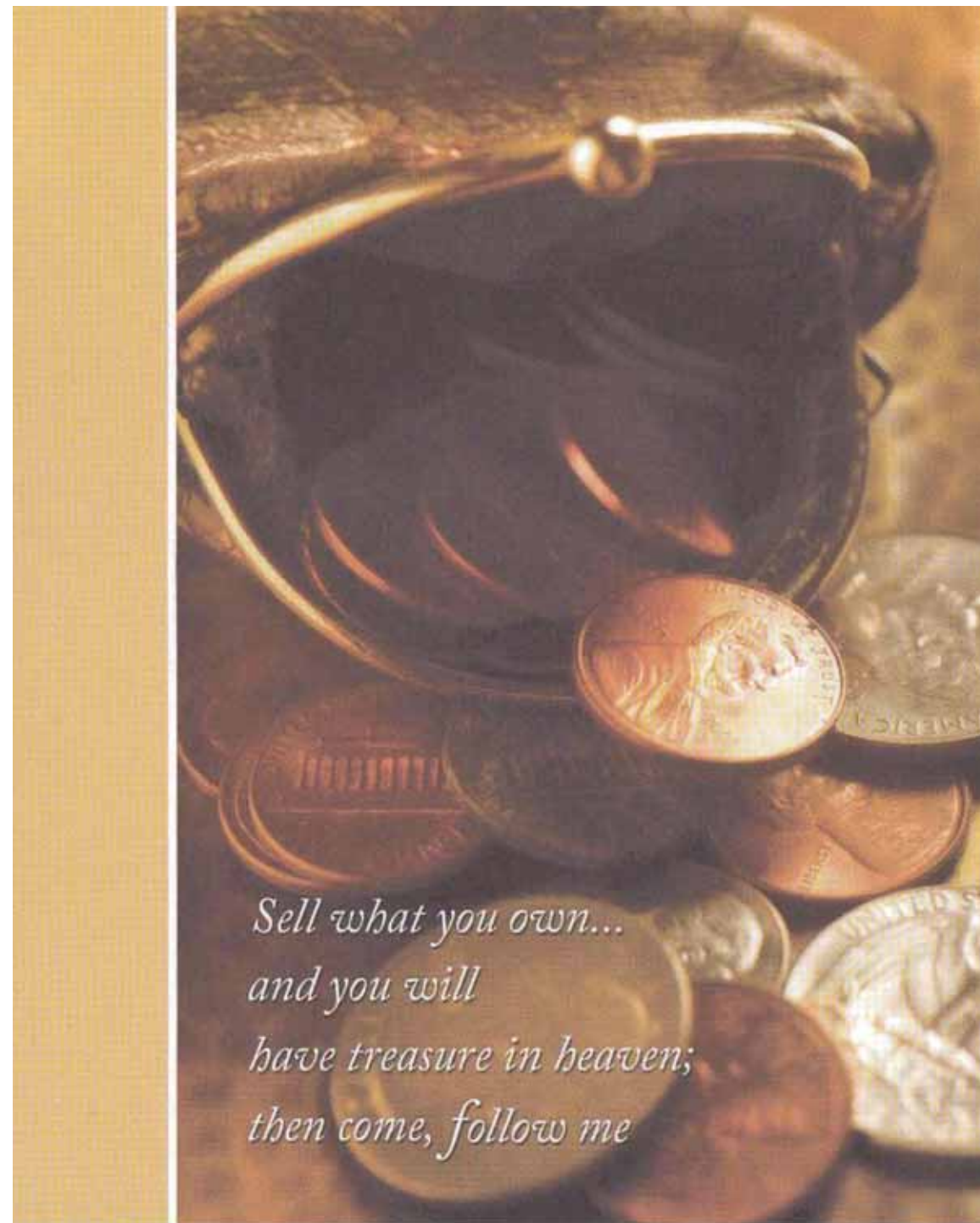
