During the Advent season we are going to bring back the Reverse Advent Calendar. Each day of December there is a scripture and a food item to be collected for our food pantry. You can purchase the items all at once or week by week as you go along. I heard a great idea last week about teaming up with grandparents or other families to fill a box (I'd love to give credit to whoever had that idea, but I'm blanking on who it was at the moment). Then at either the 10am or 5pm service on Christmas Eve, please bring back your filled up box as part of our celebration for that day! I offered a challenge to pass our total boxes from last year of 20, and I'm confident that we can do that this year.



HELPING THOSE IN NEED

In early November, Luann and I were doing a video chat with fellow Moorhead graduates (Trish and Craig) from South Carolina. Part of our conversation dealt with our love and trust of God. Trish told the story of her son, Ryan, stopping to get gas on a rainy evening. He noticed a man and a woman sitting by the side of the station out of the rain. Their motorcycle stood nearby, but what grabbed his attention was the woman seemed distraught. Then he heard a voice that got his attention to check out the couple. As he talked to them, he felt the Holy Spirit moved him to offer help. I asked filled his needs, and you visited Him in prison. Trish and Craig if they would be willing to share this story with you. Here is Trish's story that includes a God Whisper and nudge.

Ryan was driving back to Chester from Charlotte one evening late and needed to pull into a gas station for gas. His wife and 2 kids were asleep. When he pulled into the gas station he was the only car filling up. He no-

ticed a motorcycle (he always looks at them because he is a biker, also) and two people just sitting on the concrete outside the gas station. He watched the couple as he was filling up his car and noticed that they seemed upset as the two were talking. The woman seemed to be elements this year because there is no room for them. crying. He felt like he was supposed to go talk with the couple, and knew that he would probably ask them if he could help them and, of course, pray for them.

He found out that the couple had driven from Virginia recently, coming to the Charlotte, NC area for work, but the job didn't pan out. They were now out of money, and had been sleeping in the elements for days. They didn't know what to do. Our son prayed for them, and then he felt that he needed to offer them a place to stay for the night. He paid for them to put gas in their motorcycle, and told the bikers to follow him home. Our son and his wife housed them for about a week and then things started to show the Lord's intervention in the whole situation.....

- -The couple started attending church, and rededicated their lives to following the Lord
- -Our son, through connections, helped the man find a
- -The couple found a park close by to camp out with loaned camping equipment (From Craig and Trish)
- -The couple has now been given a car
- -People have given monetary gifts to help them get back on their feet
- -There is a motor home coming available for them soon

All of the above has happened in a couple months. The couple is learning to trust the Lord and also learning to trust people again. (They have been recipients of so much rejection in the past 5 years). Anyway, it's so

important for us to stay in tune, and to follow a nudge from the Lord. Who knows what lives will be changed by reaching out with the Lord's love! Love always works!!

Sometimes we are quick to judge someone by their looks. I'm sure I have missed opportunities to feed and clothe Jesus. This story was a great remember of what Jesus expects from us. From Matt. 25-34-40 paraphrased: Jesus explained that we are like animals, when He returns, He will divide the sheep from the goats. He was hungry and you gave Him food and drink. When He needed clothing, or was sick you Unfortunately, the righteous will answer him by asking when did we see you hungry, thirsty, or in need of care?

I found out recently, that my daughter and her husband buy winter outerwear each year for one of their daughters classmates
